INTER

Vs

SASSUOLO



Sassuolo have won seven of their 15 matches against Inter in Serie A TIM (D2 L6), against no side have they won more games in the competition.

Inter are unbeaten in their last four games against Sassuolo in Serie A TIM (W2 D2), having they lost each of the previous four league matches against them.

After winning their first two home matches against Sassuolo in Serie A TIM, Inter have picked up just two points in their last five league games at the Meazza stadium against the Neroverdi.

Inter have won each of their last eight Serie A TIM games, while the only previous occasion that they have achieved at least nine league wins in a row was in 2007, when the Nerazzurri established the Serie A TIM record for consecutive victories (17).

Inter have won their last 10 home games in Serie A TIM, last doing better back in 2011, when they won 13 consecutive home matches.

Sassuolo have lost five of their last seven away games in Serie A TIM (W1 D1), having lost none of the previous seven matches on the road (W5 D2).

Sassuolo have conceded 2+ goals in each of their last five league games and they have never recorded a longer such streak in Serie A TIM history.

Inter forwards Romelu Lukaku and Lautaro Martínez both scored more than one goal in a Serie A TIM game for the first time in their careers back in October 2019 against Sassuolo, winning 4-3.

Domenico Berardi has scored 20.2% of Sassuolo's goals in Serie A TIM (80/397): considering the teams to have played at least five seasons in the Italian top-flight, only Massimo Palanca for Catanzaro (23.7%) and Silvio Piola for Pro Vercelli (20.3%) had recorded a higher such ratio in the competition.

Sassuolo's Domenico Berardi has scored six goals against Inter in Serie A TIM since 2013/14 (the season of his top-flight debut) - no other player has scored more goals against the Nerazzurri in this period, level with Gonzalo Higuaín and Radja Nainggolan.
