JUVENTUS Vs NAPOLI



Napoli have won their last two Serie A TIM games against Juventus: the last time they achieved three consecutive wins against the Bianconeri was in 2011, under Walter Mazzarri.

Since the first season of the record streak of consecutive Serie A TIM titles won by Juventus (2011/12), no side has achieved more wins against the Bianconeri in Serie A TIM than Napoli (five, level with AS Roma).

Juventus have won eight of their last nine home matches against Napoli in Serie A TIM; the Bianconeri's only defeat in this period arrived in April 2018: 0-1 courtesy of Kalidou Koulibaly's header in injury time.

After a streak of seven consecutive home wins, Juventus lost their most recent home game in Serie A TIM (0-1 against Benevento). The Bianconeri have never lost two games in a row at the Allianz Stadium in the competition (the last time was back in March 2011, under Luigi Delneri at the Olimpico Grande Torino stadium).

With another win, Napoli - currently eight away wins in this current league season - could exceed the number of away wins achieved in the entirety of last season in Serie A TIM.

Napoli have won their last four Serie A TIM matches: the Partenopei have yet to record five consecutive wins in the current league season.

Gennaro Gattuso has won two of his five Serie A TIM matches as a manager against Juventus (L3) - both with Napoli: among the coaches currently in the competition, he has the highest win percentage against the Bianconeri in Serie A (40%).

After not scoring a goal in his first four matches against Napoli for either Real Madrid or Juventus in all competitions, Cristiano Ronaldo has netted three goals in his last five matches against the Partenopei.

Federico Chiesa has scored 12 goals for Juventus in all competitions, 10 of these have been netted in 2021. In 2021, he is the only Italian player currently in Serie A TIM with 10+ goals in all competitions.

Lorenzo Insigne has scored three goals against Juventus in Serie A TIM: since 2000, only Marek Hamsik (six) has netted more against the Bianconeri with Napoli (José Callejón and Edinson Cavani also scored three goals).
