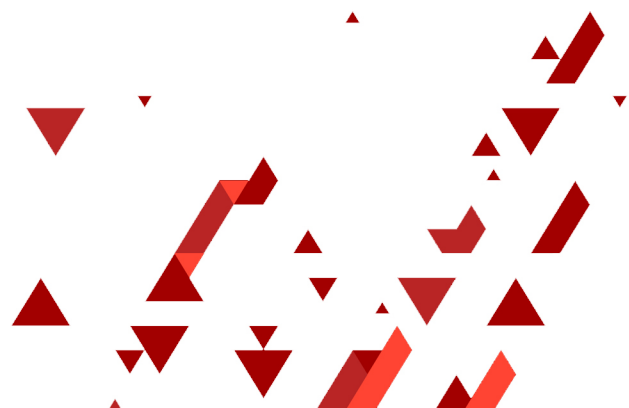

This is the 27th meeting between Inter Milan and AC Milan in the Coppa Italia: the Rossoneri have won 10 times, while the Nerazzurri have eight victories (eight draws).

AC Milan have qualified (or won the trophy) in five of their eight knockout matches against Inter Milan in the Coppa Italia - however, the last time these two sides clashed in a two-legged tie (quarter-finals of 1999/2000 campaign) the Nerazzurri were the ones to progress.

AC Milan are unbeaten in their last three games against Inter Milan across all competitions (W1, D2) - the Rossoneri last had a longer streak without defeat against the Nerazzurri in April 2005 (10 matches in that case).

For the 14th time in their history, Inter Milan and AC Milan will face each other four times in a single season (this is the first since 2004/05, three AC Milan wins and one draw in that case) - in seven of the previous 13, the Rossoneri have remained unbeaten in all four seasonal matches.

Inter Milan have been eliminated in each of their last four Coppa Italia semi-finals, after progressing in six of the previous seven times they reached this point of the tournament: overall, the Nerazzurri are the side that have suffered the most defeats at this stage of the competition (19).

AC Milan have lost only one of their last nine Coppa Italia matches (W4, D4): a defeat against Inter Milan in the quarter-finals of the last edition of the tournament. That match ended 2-1 on 26th January 2021 and was decided by a Christian Eriksen direct free kick in the 97th minute (Lukaku and Ibrahimovic the other scorers).

None of the last 28 goals in the Milan Derby across all competitions have been scored by an Italian player: the last one was on 27th December 2017, by Patrick Cutrone (in the Coppa Italia). His goal in the 104th minute saw the Rossoneri qualify for the semi-finals of the competition.

Hakan Calhanoglu has been directly involved in both of Inter's goals against Milan this season (in the two Serie A games, a penalty in the first game and an assist for Ivan Perisic in the second) - the Turkish player, however, hasn't scored or assisted in his last 150 minutes played in the Coppa Italia.

Edin Dzeko has scored the most goals at the Giuseppe Meazza stadium in all competitions this season (13) - since his arrival in Italy, the Bosnian player has scored five goals against AC Milan in all competitions (all for AS Roma), four of which were netted at San Siro.

Thanks to two goals against Inter Milan in the last Serie A meeting, Olivier Giroud is close to equalling Jean-Pierre Papin as the top French scorer in the history of the Milan Derby in all competitions (three goals).

## JUVENTUS Vs FIORENTINA

Juventus and Fiorentina have faced 15 times in the Coppa Italia: the Bianconeri have won five games (including the last two), with the Viola winning six (four draws).

Juventus have qualified from the last three meetings with Fiorentina in the Coppa Italia knockout phase – the Viola's last qualification in the competition against the Bianconeri was in the semi-finals in 1960/61 (3-1 for the Tuscans).

Juventus have won 12 of their last 16 matches in all competitions against Fiorentina, including two times in the current season (both 1-0). The other four games have comprised of two draws and two Viola wins, the last of which was a 3-0 victory at the Allianz Stadium in Turin (22/12/2020 in Serie A).

Juventus have progressed from their last six Coppa Italia semi-finals, with their last elimination coming in 2012/13 against Lazio.

Fiorentina could reach the Coppa Italia final for the first time since 2013/14, after they eliminated Udinese in the semi-finals (but lost the final vs Napoli) - since then the Viola have been eliminated on the two occasions they have reached this phase, in 2018/19 by Atalanta and in 2014/15 by Juventus.

Juventus have lost only one of their last 25 home games in the Coppa Italia (W20, D4), a defeat against Fiorentina in the 2014/15 semi-finals – Mohamed Salah netted a brace for the Viola, with Fernando Llorente scoring for the Bianconeri.

With 53 shots each, Juventus and Fiorentina are the two teams that have attempted the most shots in the Coppa Italia in 2022 - however, the Bianconeri have five shots more on target than the Viola (26 v 21) and more than any other team in this period.

Massimiliano Allegri has reached the Coppa Italia final four times as Juventus manager, already more than any other Bianconeri manager in history - his only elimination before the final in the competition was in the 2018/19 quarter-finals (0-3 defeat vs Atalanta).

Paulo Dybala has scored only one goal in nine appearances for Juventus against Fiorentina in all competitions (on 13th December 2015 in Serie A) - among the 17 teams he has faced more than five times with Juventus, the Viola are the one against whom the "Joya" has scored the fewest goals.

Krzysztof Piatek has scored 12 goals in 10 overall appearances in the Coppa Italia between Genoa, Milan and Fiorentina. While his first nine goals for the Rossoblu and the Rossoneri all arrived at home, the three scored for Viola in 2022 have all come away from home.
